



**GREETINGS FROM NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH**

Lincoln Hills' Neighborhood Watch is an adjunct to the National Association of Town Watch. Its purpose is to help residents organize so there will be less crime and more safety in their immediate neighborhoods. It is also a great way to meet and know your neighbors.

Each village has a Village Coordinator and is divided into mail stations. Residents using the same mail station are considered a mail station team. One volunteer of the mail station team acts as a Captain whose job is to obtain emergency contact information to complete the Resident Contact Information form for the mail station. This roster includes each resident's name, address, phone numbers and email addresses as well as pet information and Vial of Life for that mail station. This roster is shared with the Village Coordinator and is to be kept current.

The Captain will forward any security and crime related alerts to his residents although each resident is encouraged to sign up to receive their own alerts from our Neighborhood Watch Alerts Coordinator. On the same website you can also obtain an Incident Report to forward crime related information to the Lincoln Police Department, a Vacation Check Request form to conduct a vacation check of your home
